RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR GRANT FOR RIVER BEND ROAD DRAINAGE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Town of Grafton is interested in obtaining a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to for the purpose of implementing measures (as described in the application and pursuant to § 281.65 or 281.66, Wis. Stats., and chapters NR 151, 153, and 155, Wis. Adm. Code) to control nonpoint source water pollution at an intermittent stream which crosses River Bend Road (the Project) and;

WHEREAS, a cost sharing agreement is requested to carry out the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Grafton has budgeted a sum sufficient to complete the project and;

HEREBY AUTHORIZES the Town Chairman to act on behalf of the Town of Grafton to submit an application to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for any financial aid that may be available and also:

- Submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within 6 months of project completion date;
- Submit signed documents; and
- Take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete the approved project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that applicant will comply with all state and federal rules and regulations relating to this project, the cost-share agreement, and nonpoint source water pollution.
