RESOLUTION REQUESTING SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION ON LAKEFIELD ROAD/COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY "T" BETWEEN PORT WASHINGTON ROAD AND GREEN BAY ROAD

WHEREAS, the Town of Grafton is a body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County; and

WHEREAS, at the Annual Meeting residents raised concerns regarding the speed limit on Lakefield Road (County Trunk Highway "T") between Port Washington Road and Green Bay Road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes safety concerns remain for County Trunk Highway "T" between Port Washington Road and Green Bay Road, and that reducing the speed limit thereon from 55 MPH to 45 MPH will protect the health, welfare and safety of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes that a 45 MPH speed limit on Lakefield Road/County Trunk Highway "T" between Port Washington Road and Green Bay Road would be beneficial to all; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that a traffic and speed study may be required prior to the reduction of any speed limit set forth in Section 3.02 of the Ozaukee County Traffic Code and therefore requests the County to conduct the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Grafton Board of Supervisors does hereby request that the speed limit on Lakefield Road/County Trunk Highway "T" between Port Washington Road and Green Bay Road be reduced from 55 MPH to 45 MPH.
